AT HOME

give them shelter

Cats have a thing for cardboard, but a plain old box doesn't do much for your décor. Instead, tuck felines into this Modernist chalet (\$23, loyalluxe.com). The faux-bois cabin, made from recycled cardboard, is shipped flat for extra eco-friendly credit. The Roll-a-Nest (from \$5, at pet stores) looks like a decorative object but encourages natural nesting instincts. Woven from sisal, the hideout doubles as a snack for guinea pigs and gerbils in need of a nibble.



ON THE GO
take a walk

Help your pup put its best paw forward with a handsome collar or harness. These four offer style points and creature comfort.

CLASSIC COLLAR

Harry Barker's recycled-plastic lead and collar (\$25 and \$19, trixieandpeanut.com) have a très chic horse-bit pattern and are good for short walks with dogs of any size.

JACKET HARNESS

As luxurious as a Barbour jacket, this waxed canvas harness (\$54, foundmyanimal.com) and coordinating rope leash (\$60) keep dogs under control comfortably; 25 percent of the profits go to the Louis Animal Foundation, which spays and neuters animals for free in rural areas.

HARNESS

Because they place less strain on a dog's neck, harnesses are best for training and long outings. The Martha Stewart Pets padded leather harness (\$28, petsmart.com) distributes tension; the matching leash (\$25) can hold a bag dispenser.

MARTINGALE COLLAR

More humane than a choke chain, Wagging Green's design has a control loop attached to a stable collar and leash (\$21 and \$23, olivegreendog.com). Bonus: They're made of pesticide-free bamboo.



PLAYTIME
frisky behavior

The all-natural Kong Crinkle Fish (\$6 each, at pet stores) entices cats with feathers, cotton-encased catnip, and crackly sounds.

The Nina Ottosson cat pyramid (\$12, pawlickers.com) makes your feline companions work to get at the morsels hidden within.

The Weebles-shaped Martha Stewart Pets Crochet Squeak Toy Chick (\$10, petsmart.com) stands up to moderate canine chewers.

The yucca Bird Kabob (\$6, birdkabob.com) keeps parrots, macaws, or cockatiels happily shredding and pecking away for hours.

Play fetch with this handmade felted-wool dinosaur (\$12, acheerfulpet.com); proceeds benefit Nepalese workers.

Fill the Orbee-Tuff eggplant and strawberry chomper toys (\$15 and \$10.45 each, planetdog.com) with a meaty dog treat.
